 - 04 Ensure that construction work meets all specified design, quality and safety requirements, along with compliance to all quality control procedures and regulatory requirements.
 - 05 Monitor progress and identify potential delays, risks, or bottlenecks, and implement corrective measures as needed. Regularly inspect and monitor the quality of work performed by subcontractors and construction workers.
 - 06 Track project costs and manage the construction budget, ensuring the project stays within the financial scope. Review and approve contractor invoices, ensuring they align with contract terms and work completed.
 - 07 Manage all aspects of site safety, ensuring a safe working environment in compliance with industry safety standards, local regulations, and company policies.
 - 08 Manage vendors (delivery, supplies, billing etc) to handle site logistics, including equipment, material deliveries and site organization, to minimize disruptions to the work.
 - 09 Ensure compliance with environmental regulations, health and safety standards, and industry best practices.
 - 10 Identify cost-saving opportunities without compromising quality or safety standards.
 - 11 Serve as the main point of contact for all site-related communication, including coordination with clients, consultants, vendors, and local authorities.
